



OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTIES

1. THE SCHOOL WILL:

- a) Direct and manage the program taking the last decision regarding the participation in it of host families and non-resident students.
- b) Manage or supervise the processing of all formal documentation necessary for the development of the process with the collaboration of the requesting family and host families in compliance with the obligations that correspond to each of them.
- c) Subscribe and keep in force a policy of civil liability and accident of the child participating in the program.
- d) Subscribe and keep in force a private health insurance for the non-resident student that covers all health contingencies in Spanish territory including repatriation in any circumstance.
- e) Have an alternative host family within a period of no more than ten days in case of difficulties of cohabitation of the Host Family with the non-resident student (if there is no alternative).
- f) Contribute to the expenses of maintenance and care of the student received.

2. THE HOST FAMILY WILL:

- a) Maintain during all the development of the program the necessary requirements to participate in it as host family. Among them, the following are considered essential:
 - Be parents of students enrolled in the Sevilla International College San Francisco de Paula from at least two previous courses.
 - Count in your home with the adequate conditions to house the non-resident student in your family home during the school year, endorsed and approved by the responsible person appointed by the School.
 - Maintain the conditions expressed in the corresponding form on host conditions.
 - That the students do not have to alternate addresses by separation or judicial ruling.
 - That none of the adults in the household has been or is not convicted for the commission of crimes against freedom and sexual indemnity, proving this circumstance through the corresponding Certificate of the Ministry of Justice.



- That none of the members of the family have detectable infectious-contagious diseases.
 - That the tutors of their children in the previous two years, plus the current one, certify, with the approval of the Vice-Direction for Individualization, the suitability of the collaboration and the coincidence of values and educational approaches between the family and the School.
- b) Receive the non-resident student in his family home on a lodging and full board basis, who, meeting the conditions specified in the attached form, will be presented by the School.
- c) Assume the custody of the non-resident student by delegation of the parents of the same. The student will be welcomed into the family as a member of the same, participating in their ordinary activities, remaining under their care and supervision while not in the School.
- d) Know the commitment reaches the entire school year, including weekends, holidays and holiday periods of Christmas, Easter and April Fair, without prejudice to the student may in any of these times at the initiative of their parents absent from home of the Host Family.
- e) Immediately inform the School of the possible concurrence of difficulties in coexistence with the non-resident student, as well as any relevant circumstance regarding the personal development of said student.
- f) Authorize the Sevilla International College San Francisco de Paula the treatment of the personal data provided, as well as its transfer to the competent authorities and third parties participating in the educational process or in the program of attention to non-resident students.

3. THE APPLICANT FAMILY WILL:

- a) Fully accept the rules of the Program and formalize the documentation provided therein.
- b) Request and obtain, in case of foreign students, all the authorizations required by the authorities for their stay in Spain for study reasons for the period necessary to attend the enrolled teachings.
- c) Expressly delegate the custody of the student not residing in the Host Family, formalizing for this purpose the precise documentation for this according to the regulations that apply to it.
- d) Authorize Sevilla International College San Francisco de Paula to process the personal data provided, as well as its assignment to the competent authorities and third



parties participating in the educational process or in the non-resident student host program.

4. THE NON-RESIDENT STUDENT WILL:

1. Comply with the operating norms of the center and the specific ones established in the program of Attention to non-resident students.
2. Obeying and attending to the indications of the host family as if it were their effective parents.
3. Adapt to the rhythms, habits and customs of the host family, fostering an adequate coexistence within it.
